Warning Instructions

1. Load Capacity

Cleaning Instructions

1. Use a soft cloth dampened with warm water and mild detergent. Dry with a clean, dry cloth to prevent water spots or streaks.
2. For stubborn stain use hot, soapy water or a non-abrasive cleaner suitable for metal surfaces.
3. Avoid harsh chemicals and abrasive sponges or steel wool, which can harm and scratch the surface.
